What the programme provides:

An Insider Perspective

Through a 90-minute interactive seminar, participants will be taken under the politics and headlines to explore what really goes into the UK-US relations and the opportunities available for young people to participate in it.

A Platform for New Ideas

Participants have the opportunity to highlight the issues and global challenges that matter most to them and ideas on what both countries can do to tackle them. Feedback will be included in a publication and distributed to UK and US Government.
